



## Colorado 4th Congressional District Survey Results

**Q1** Some people say that the EPA needs to do more to hold polluters accountable and protect the air and water. Others say that the EPA does too much and places too many costly restrictions on businesses and individuals.

Which point of view do you agree with more?

*EPA needs to do more to hold polluters accountable and protect the air and water*..... 54%

*EPA does too much and places too many costly restrictions on businesses and individuals*..... 46%

**Q2** Do you favor or oppose the EPA setting new standards with stricter limits on air pollution?

*Favor* ..... 55%

*Oppose* ..... 45%

**Q3** Some say Congress should step in and prevent the EPA from limiting carbon dioxide pollution. For example, the head of the America Petroleum Institute says Congress should decide when and how greenhouse gases should be regulated. But others say Congress should let EPA do its job. The head of the American Public Health Association says that blocking the EPA's work to reduce carbon dioxide could mean the difference between a healthy life for many Americans or chronic debilitating illness. Which opinion do you support?

*Congress should let the EPA do its job* ..... 66%

**Q4** Colorado Congressman Cory Gardner is considering a proposal that would block the EPA from limiting carbon dioxide pollution. Some, like the National Association of Manufacturers, say Congress should block the EPA because "EPA's overregulation threatens manufacturers, businesses and jobs throughout America. Its actions will increase manufacturers' energy costs and make it more difficult to compete." Others, like the American Lung Association, say Congress should not block the EPA because doing so "would strip away Clean Air Act protections that safeguard Americans and their families from air pollution that puts their lives at risk." Knowing these two points of view, would you support or oppose Congress blocking the EPA?

*Support* ..... 39%

**Q5** Colorado Congressman Cory Gardner recently supported a bill to block EPA from reducing carbon pollution. Having heard what leading public health groups say about the health effects if Congress blocks the EPA, do you think that Congressman Gardner's decision to support this bill is good for your family's health, or bad?
